

“Visual EPR” Software License Agreement

READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE INSTALLING THIS SOFTWARE.

BY INSTALLING AND USING THIS SOFTWARE, YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

IF YOU **DO NOT AGREE** TO THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT, **DO NOT INSTALL OR USE** THE SOFTWARE.

YOU AGREE THAT YOUR INSTALLATION OR USE OF THE SOFTWARE ACKNOWLEDGES THAT YOU HAVE READ THIS LICENSE, UNDERSTAND IT, AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

This Agreement states the terms and conditions upon which V.Grachev offers to license the “Visual EPR” programs, together with all related documentation and accompanying items including, but not limited to, the executable programs, libraries and data files associated with such programs (collectively, the "software").

The software are licensed, not sold, to you by V.Grachev for use only under the terms of this license, and V.Grachev reserves any rights not expressly granted to you. You assume responsibility for the selection of the software to achieve your intended results, and for the installation of and use of, and results obtained from, the software. V.Grachev grants you a nonexclusive license to use the software, providing that you agree to the following:

1. Installation and Use

If you purchased a license, you may install and use the software on an office, home and/or portable (laptop) computer, solely for your own use. You may transfer the program from one computer to another provided that only one copy of the program is used at any time. You may not distribute copies of the documentation or the programs in any form without prior written consent from V.Grachev.

2. Backup Copies

You may make unlimited copies of the software and distribution media if done solely for backup and archival purposes. You may not use the backup copies for any purpose except restoration of the software after loss.

3. No Transfer of License.

You may not rent, lease, sublicense, lend the software or transfer your license of the software to anyone.

You may, however, transfer media (graphics, files, etc.) generated by “Visual EPR” to another party, providing that the following conditions are satisfied:

- a. The other party acknowledges the use of this software (see the item 4. Citation).
- b. You notify V.Grachev of the transfer.

4. Citation

You are welcome to use “Visual EPR” generated media (graphics, files, etc.) in any of your publications: there is no separate licensing agreement or fee for this. However, we do require you to acknowledge the use of this software. A suitable example would be:

“EPR spectra and/or angular dependencies were simulated using “Visual EPR” programs by V.Grachev (www.physics.montana.edu/faculty/Grachev)”

5. Copyright

The software is owned by V.Grachev, and is protected by United States copyright laws and international treaty provisions. You may not remove the copyright notice from any copy of the software or any copy of the written materials accompanying the software.

6. Limited Warranty

V.Grachev warrants to the registered owner that the media on which the software is provided will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use for a period of ninety days from the date of delivery to you. V.Grachev makes no warranties, express or implied, including without limitation the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, regarding the software. V.Grachev do not warrant, guarantee or make any representations regarding the use or the results of the use of the software in terms of its correctness, accuracy, reliability or otherwise. The entire risk as to the results and performance of the software is assumed by you.

7. Limitation of Liability

In no event will V.Grachev be liable to you for any consequential, incidental or indirect damages (including damages for loss of business profits, business interruption, loss of business information, and the like) arising out of the use or inability to use the software, even if V.Grachev has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

8. Governing Law

This agreement shall be governed by the law of the State of Montana, the USA.
